This combined support enabled the acquisition of the Olympus EVIS Universal Endoscopic Video Platform. This advanced system delivers **unparalleled imaging quality**, empowering ENT providers to swiftly develop precise treatment plans. Equipped with three cutting-edge, highly advanced scopes, this technology is designed to tackle some of the most challenging cancer sites.

In this new outpatient clinic, physicians can now perform biopsies, laser treatments and injections without requiring patients to undergo procedures in the operating room. By providing access to these advanced diagnostic and treatment options locally, we are not only **transforming cancer care** but also reaffirming our commitment to improving the health and well-being of our community in eastern North Carolina.
